Travel just 140 miles north of Chicago for a fun-filled weekend of bicycling, water sports and the "best Farmers' Market in the nation". Madison has over 100 miles of bikeways winding around the city and lakes. When you're not biking, rent a boat, go to one of the area's 13 beaches, or enjoy the UW culture (once known as the Berkeley of the Midwest) and great eateries. For retail therapy, visit the eclectic boutiques and specialty shops along the State St. mall.

We will be staying on Capitol Square at the Best Western Inn on the Park. The Square is the center of downtown activity, sitting on Madison's isthmus between Lakes Mendota and Monona. The Capital City Bike Trail is a few steps away and the Dane County Farmers' Market rings the 19th-century Capitol. The hotel rooms were recently renovated and it offers an indoor pool and hot tub and fitness room.

The trip includes two nights lodging (two to a room), Friday night welcoming margarita party by the pool, and a Saturday night dinner at the Samba Restaurant and Brazilian Grill.

There are reservations for 60 people- the trip will fill quickly; don't delay signing up, or you will miss this fabulous weekend!
